Access to the Internet and Samford Network Services

- E-mail (bulldogmail.samford.edu)
- Samford University Portal (portal.samford.edu)
- Samford's Learning Management System (moodle.samford.edu)

Samford User Name - Your Samford User Name will serve as one part of the information needed to log in to various information systems such as the Samford Portal (a web-based gateway to many campus services).

Samford E-mail Address - Your User Name, together with '@samford.edu', serves as your Samford e-mail address (ex. jdoe@samford.edu)

Temporary Password - This temporary password will not provide access to Samford University systems such as email and the portal, but will allow you to choose a new permanent password to use for these systems. To choose a new password, go to pwchange.samford.edu and login using your Samford User Name and the temporary password.

Your password will be known only to you and must not be shared with anyone. The same password is used to access all systems so sharing your password to let someone else see your email also allows that person to view and change personal information and to access any Samford University systems on your behalf.

SUID - All persons are assigned a 9-digit number that will serve as a unique identifier for administrative records. This number will start with the digit 9 and replaces traditional dependence on the Social Security Number as an identifier. There will be times when the Social Security Number is still required (such as on financial aid applications) but the SUID will be used in most circumstances.

Connecting to Samford's Wireless Network



- Samford University offers wireless connection all across campus. This service provides students and employees the convenience and flexibility of using portable computing devices at non-traditional locations around campus.
- The primary wireless network (SSID) for Samford students and employees is called **Samford User**. This network requires you to authenticate by entering in your **Samford User Name** and **Samford Password**. By connecting to this wireless network you can reach the outside Internet and all on-campus services.
- **Take Note:** Samford uses an enterprise class wireless network and not all devices support the type of authentication we use. Examples include certain e-readers (Nook and Kindle, wireless printers, and netbooks running certain Linux based OS's. We suggest you ensure support for the WPA2 authentication method before purchasing a new device for on campus use.

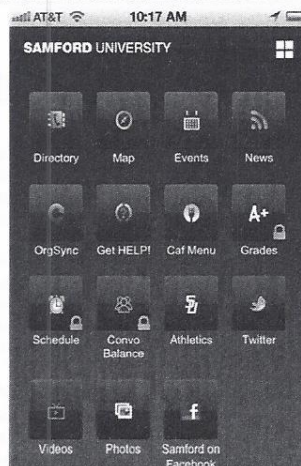

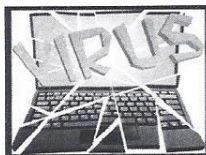

Keeping yourself and your computer safe from cyber criminals



- **Never give out your Samford password to anyone.**
- **Maintain current antivirus/antimalware software protection**, with daily updates to virus definition files. Several free AV programs are available if you do not currently have one installed.
- **Keep Operating System and software applications up to date.** Computer hackers use vulnerabilities in unpatched software applications to gain access to your computer and your personal information.
- **Never respond to email scams** which ask you to submit your secret login password. These messages are scams and are designed to trick you into submitting your personal account information for malicious intent.
- **Make sure you completely log off when using public access computers** such as computer labs or kiosk computers.
